On May 3, 2012, the Board of Nursing reviewed the Fitness to Practice evaluation required pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated April 1, 2011. Ms. Foley submitted a Follow Up Visit note from her physician instead of a Fitness to Practice evaluation by an independent pain management specialist who has not treated her at any time. The Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Fitness to Practice report submitted is deemed unsatisfactory and is not accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Briana Foley shall submit a Fitness to Practice evaluation report from a psychologist that specializes in the treatment of chronic illness (pain). The evaluator must not have treated her at any time and shall have been approved by the Board prior to the evaluation being performed.

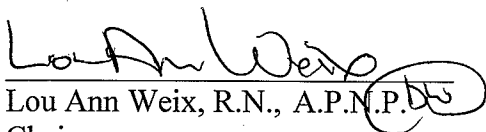
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that at a minimum the Fitness to Practice evaluation shall include:

- Her ability to make good decisions.
- Her ability to handle stress and think critically
- The current status and prognosis of her recovery
- Whether she is overall safe to practice nursing

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Fitness to Practice evaluation report shall be submitted within three (3) months of the date of this Order.
