By Order dated September 12, 2011, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board) ordered the Respondents to pay costs of the proceeding (costs) in the amount of four hundred thirty (\$430) dollars and a forfeiture of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars. The Respondents were to make payments within ninety (90) days of the date of the Order.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondents have failed to make any of the payments.

Pursuant to the terms of the September 12, 2011 Order, failure to make the payment as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondents' licenses without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Oanh K. Do's manicurist license (#4516-85) is SUSPENDED until she has complied with payment of costs of the proceeding¹ and forfeitures as set forth in the September 12, 2011 Order.

IT IS ALSO FURTHER ORDERED that the establishment license of Elan Nails (#2931-71) is SUSPENDED until it has complied with payment of costs and forfeitures as set forth in the September 12, 2011 Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
