PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On September 12, 2011, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board reprimanded Respondent Karen Bui, license # 6610-85, and ordered her to, within 90 days of the Order, to pay a forfeiture of \$1,675.00, and costs of the proceeding of \$165.00, for a total amount of \$1,840.00.

Also on September 12, 2011, Respondent Fancy Nail (llicense # 3110-71) was reprimanded and ordered to pay a forfeiture of \$1,675.00, and costs of the proceeding of \$165.00, for a total amount of \$1,840.00.

On September 30, 2011, the Division of Enforcement Department Monitor received a petition from Respondent Bui, on behalf of herself and as the responsible party for Fancy Nail, requesting a reduction of the total amount of Respondents' combined obligation of \$3,680.00, and a payment plan consisting of \$200.00 per month in satisfaction of the resulting amount.

Pursuant to the Respondents' request, the Board reviewed this matter at its January 30, 2012 meeting. Respondent Bui appeared before the Board to explain the reasons for Respondents' request. Based upon the record presented, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board, finding that no good cause exists to reduce the amount of forfeitures and costs assessed against the Respondents, makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Respondents' request to reduce the amount of forfeitures and costs assessed against the Respondents is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondents' request for a payment plan is GRANTED as follows:

1. Respondent Karen Bui, license # 6610-85 shall, within 30 days of the date of this Order, make a payment of not less than \$150.00. Payments in the amount of \$100.00 shall be made monthly thereafter until the total amount of the fines and costs assessed against Respondent Bui has been satisfied.

- 2. Respondent Fancy Nail, license # 3110-71), shall, within 30 days of the date of this Order, make a payment of not less than \$150.00. Payments in the amount of \$100.00 shall be made monthly thereafter until the total amount of the fines and costs assessed against Fancy Nail has been paid.
- 3. Payment of forfeitures and costs shall be made using certified funds (cashier's check, money order or certified check) payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to:

- 4. Any missed payments by either Respondent will be grounds for immediate suspension without further order of the Board.
- 5. All provisions of the September 12, 2011 Order not otherwise modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.

The Board will not consider any requests to modify the conditions of this or its September 12, 2011 Orders before the expiration of six months from the date of this Order.
