On September 12, 2012, the Pharmacy Examining Board considered Petitioner Ryan J. Nelson's request to modify certain conditions imposed in the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated September 14, 2011. Based upon the information of record which shows Petitioner has been compliant with the terms of the September 14, 2011 Order and has the support of both his work supervisor and therapist for the requests in his petition, the Board now finds and makes the following:



ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request for a reduction in the frequency of Mr. Nelson's drug and alcohol screenings is GRANTED. Mr. Nelson shall now undergo drug and alcohol screenings at the rate of 36 times per year with 1 hair test.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Nelson's request for an increase in the number of hours per week that he may work in the capacity of a pharmacist in charge is GRANTED. Mr. Nelson may now work as a pharmacist in charge for 8 hours per week.

This order is effective September 12, 2012.
