On November 7, 2012, the Dentistry Examining Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of AA/NA meetings and drug and alcohol screens, pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated November 2, 2011. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:


ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification to the AA/NA attendance requirement for Steven Schnoll, D.D.S. (#3039-15) be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Dr. Schnoll's AA/NA attendance requirement shall now be reduced to six (6) meetings per month.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification to the frequency of drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Dr. Schnoll shall now undergo drug and alcohol screens at a reduced frequency of 36 times per year.
