PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Roger Pinc, M.D., Respondent (D.O.B.: December 28, 1928), holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin (No. 42392-20) which was first granted on July 21, 2000. Respondent's registration to practice under that license expired on October 31, 2009 and Respondent holds the right to renew this registration.
- 2. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 14557 Dwina Road, Pittsburg, IL 62974-1403.

- 3. On July 30, 2009, the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana and Respondent entered into an Order due to the following charges:
 - a. On or about February 25, 2005, Respondent was arrested in Woodford County, Kentucky for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of drug or alcohol and operating on a suspended license.
 - b. On or about May 7, 2005, Respondent renewed his Indiana Physician license and although having a criminal charge pending in Woodford County, answered "NO" to all questions.
 - c. On or about June 27, 2005, Respondent was convicted of operating while intoxicated in Woodford County, Kentucky.
 - d On or about July 4, 2005, Respondent was arrested in Warrick County, Indiana and charged with: Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated Endangering a Person, a Class A misdemeanor; Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated, a Class C Misdemeanor; Operating a Vehicle with BAC between .08 and .15, a Class C misdemeanor; Driving While Suspended, a Class A Infraction; Driving Left of Center, a Class C Infraction; and Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated with a Prior Conviction, a Class D Felony.
 - e. On or about May 29, 2007, Respondent renewed his Indiana Physician license and although being convicted of operating a vehicle while intoxicated and having a second set of criminal charges pending in Indiana, answered "NO" to all questions.
 - f. On or about November 26, 2007, Respondent pled guilty to the Warrick County, Indiana charges. Respondent was sentenced to: one year in the Warrick County Security center; five days executed with the balance to be served on reporting probation; substance abuse treatment program; and suspension of driving privileges for two years.
- 4. Respondent permanently and voluntarily surrendered his Indiana medical license.
- 5. Respondent was fined \$1,000 to be paid within ninety (90) days of from the date of the Order.
- 6. On October 28, 2009, the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs and Respondent entered into an Order that voluntarily surrendered his license which was based on Indiana's discipline.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3) and authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. Respondent, by having engaged in material deception in order to obtain a license and failure to report his pending criminal charges to the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana, has committed unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.02(2)(d)(q) and is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation of the parties is accepted.

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board accepts the voluntary surrender of Roger Pinc's license (No. 42392-20), to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, effective the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Respondent shall not practice or attempt to practice medicine or surgery in the State of Wisconsin when not currently licensed and registered. Should Respondent reapply for Wisconsin licensure, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be reissued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall at the time of re-applying for his license in the State of Wisconsin pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of THREE HUNDRED (\$300.00) dollars. Payment shall be made to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
