On January 30, 2012, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board<sup>1</sup> ordered Respondent to pay proceeding costs in the amount of one thousand fourteen (\$1,014.00) dollars and a forfeiture of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars within one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of the Order.
