By Order dated January 30, 2012, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board [now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board ("Board")] ordered Respondent to pay a forfeiture of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars. The Board further approved a payment plan pursuant to which the Respondent would pay installments of \$250.00 every sixty days until the entire forfeiture had been paid in full. The Respondent made a payment of \$250.00 on 12/6/11.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondent has failed to pay the remaining installments by their due dates [every sixty (60) days following the date of the previous payment due date].

Pursuant to the terms of the January 30, 2012 Order, failure to make the payment as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondent's licensee without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Lids and Clip's establishment license (#37266-80) is SUSPENDED until it has complied with payment forfeitures as set forth in the January 30, 2012 Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
