PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Naglaa Abdel-Al, M.D., Respondent (DOB: August 27, 1969), holds a license by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 50276-20, which was first granted April 20, 2007.

Respondent's registration to practice under that license expired on October 31, 2011 and Respondent holds the right to renew this registration.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is 13278 Roxboro Road, Windermere, FL 34786.

3. Respondent's specialty is anesthesiology.

4. On June 9, 2011 the Arizona Medical Board entered into an Order for Decree of Censure and Practice Restriction and Consent to the Same based on the following:

- a. On April 13, 2010, Respondent admitted to taking Diprivan while on duty for a surgery and abandoned the patient.
- b. On April 14, 2010 Respondent consented to an Interim Practice Restriction and underwent an assessment on May 9-12-, 2010.
- c. On October 4, 2010, Respondent entered a residential treatment program, which she successfully completed on January 7, 2011. Her diagnosis upon discharge was sedative dependence.
- d. On February 8, 2011, the Florida Physicians Health Program contractors found Respondent safe to practice and she is currently enrolled in the Florida's Physicians Recovery Network, a five- year monitoring program.

5. Respondent surrendered her license to practice medicine and surgery in California and New York.

6. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has been suspended for a five year period.

7. Respondent voluntarily agreed not to renew or reinstate her Connecticut license to practice as a physician/surgeon.

8. Respondent's holds licenses in Connecticut, Florida, Michigan, New Jersey, Ohio, and Virginia and has pending actions in those states regarding her license to practice medicine and surgery.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondent, by having been subject to discipline by the Arizona Medical Board has committed unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.02(2)(h)(q) and is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board accepts the voluntary surrender of Naglaa Abdel-Al's license (#50276-20), to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, effective the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall not practice or attempt to practice medicine or surgery in the State of Wisconsin when not currently licensed. Should Respondent reapply for Wisconsin licensure, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be reissued.

3. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of four hundred nine (\$409.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services, and mailed to:
