The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Jamil James Locker is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having license number 108-37166, first issued on 10/22/2008 and currently active. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 3863 S. Miner Street #3, Milwaukee, WI 53221.

2. On or about August 27, 2010, Respondent submitted an application to renew his private security person license and indicated that he had not been charged with, or convicted of, any felony, misdemeanor, or ordinance violation.

3. A review of certified court documents found that at the time of renewal, Respondent had a pending charge in Milwaukee County Criminal Court of Felony Child Abuse (arrested June 21, 2010). Respondent was later convicted, on February 7, 2011, of a reduced charge of Battery - Misd. A, Wis. Stat. § 940.19(1).

4. Respondent failed to report the conviction to the Department within 48 hours of the judgment of conviction.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(17) by providing false information in the application for a credential.

4. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualifications pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) by failing to report a conviction to the Department within 48 hours of judgment of conviction.

5. As a result of the violations noted above, Respondent Jamil James Locker is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

2. The Private Security Person license of Jamil James Locker (license number 108-37166) is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of fifteen (15) days beginning five (5) days after the date of this Order.

3. The Private Security Person license of Jamil James Locker (license number 108-37166) is LIMITED as follows:

a. Respondent shall successfully complete probation as ordered by Milwaukee County Circuit Court.

- b. Respondent shall submit proof of completion of probation in the form of verification from his probation officer or the court to the Department Monitor's address stated below.
- c. This Limitation shall be removed from Respondent's license after he has satisfied the Department or its designee that he has successfully completed the ordered probation.

4. Proof of successful completion of probation shall be sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:




5. In the event Respondent fails to successfully complete probation as ordered by Milwaukee County Circuit Court on March 9, 2011, Jamil James Locker's license, number 108-37166, may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be REVOKED, without further notice or hearing.

6. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
