The applicant, Gloria Bauer, has not been employed in a position that requires a nursing license within 5 years of her application for licensure by endorsement pursuant to sec. 441.04, Stats. and ch. N3.04(1m), Wis. Admin. Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a limited license shall be GRANTED to the applicant for the sole purpose of allowing her to participate in and complete the clinical portion of a nurse refresher course. The applicant shall not use the limited license to engage in any other nursing employment in the state of Wisconsin.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the limited license shall expire one (1) year from the date of issuance and shall not be renewed except by petition to the Board with good cause shown for lack of timely completion of the refresher course. Upon successful completion of the refresher course, the applicant may petition the board for a full registered nurse license.
