The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Warren A. Olson, M.D., ("Respondent") was born on March 24, 1945 and is licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin (license #18076-20). This license was first granted on August 14, 1972. This license expired on October 31, 2011 and has not been renewed. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.08(3), Respondent retains the right to renew upon payment of a fee until October 31, 2016.

- 2. Respondent's last address reported to the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is 2178 Johnson Avenue, San Luis Obispo, California.
- 3. On November 22, 1976, Respondent was granted a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of California by the Medical Board of California.
- 4. On August 4, 2010, Respondent was arrested and charged for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence and for leaving the scene of an accident. On December 21, 2010, Respondent pled no contest to the charges.
- 5. On April 8, 2011, Respondent was disciplined by the Medical Board of California for failure to report the convictions to within thirty days. Respondent has been retired from practice since July 2010 and voluntarily surrendered his California medical license in an effort to resolve the disciplinary action against him.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Board accepts the resignation and surrender of Respondent's license (#18076-20) and all rights and privileges attendant to the license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 2. Respondent shall not reapply for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and that the Department of Safety and Professional Services shall not process any application for renewal of the license of Warren A. Olson, M.D.
