ADDENDUM TO CITATION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE FORFEITURE - PAYMENT PLAN

Dear Lan Luu:

You have received a citation for \$1000 for a violation of the Barbering & Cosmetology rules regarding operating your Cali Nails salon from April 1, 2011 through November 29, 2011 without having a current manicuring establishment license, and you have requested the opportunity to enter into a payment agreement to resolve that citation. By returning an original signed copy of this letter along with partial payment, you accept the forfeiture imposed on the citation you received and agree to pay the forfeiture amount in full over the extended time period. To enter into this agreement and to accept the payment plan below:

- You must sign and date this document below and return the original to Ralph Draeger at the P.O. Box address listed above by January 16, 2012.
- You must also include a partial payment of 25% of the total amount due on the citation when returning this document. (25% of \$1000 is \$250)
- You must return a copy of the citation with this document.
- Subsequent payments of 25% of the total amount are due every 60 days following the date of the previous payment due date until the full amount has been paid and must be sent to the Department Monitor at the address above. (\$250 each time)
- You agree that if you fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, your establishment license may, in the discretion of the board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until you have complied with payment of the forfeiture.
