The Respondent, Sharron A. Steinbruner, voluntarily and knowingly hereby agrees to the issuance of a LIMITED license for the purpose of completing a board-approved nurse refresher course in lieu of submitting additional information of nursing work in another jurisdiction, current education or experience which demonstrates continued competence in the field of nursing, pursuant to s. 440.08(3)(b), Stats. and s. N 5.08(2)(b), Code, or in lieu of the right to a hearing on the denial of application for renewal of the license pursuant to s. SPS 1.08.

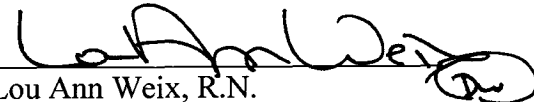
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a LIMITED license shall be GRANTED to the Respondent for the purpose of allowing participation in a board-approved nurse refresher course.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the limited license shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance. If the refresher course is not completed within one year, the limited license will expire and the Respondent will need to reapply for a limited license to complete the course.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the refresher course the Respondent may petition the board for reinstatement of a full license.
