The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Contemporary Services Corporation is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Detective Agency, having license number 62-16057, first issued on 04/19/2000 and current through 08/31/2013. Contemporary Services Corporation's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 17101 Superior St., Northridge, CA 91325.

2. On or about October 17, 2011, the Department received a complaint alleging an unlicensed individual performed security services for Contemporary Services Corporation on four occasions.

3. Respondent admits to the allegation in the complaint.

4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent Contemporary Services Corporation consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(13) by allowing an unlicensed person to perform private security duties.

3. As a result of the above violation, Respondent Contemporary Services Corporation is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)2. and 4. and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(13).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

2. Respondent Contemporary Services Corporation is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent Contemporary Services Corporation shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$270.00.

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this

Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered, Respondent's license (no. 62-16057) may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
