By Order dated April 2, 2012, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board) ordered Respondent to pay costs of the proceeding (costs) in the amount of six hundred seventy seven (\$677) dollars and a forfeiture of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars. The Respondent was to make these payments within ninety (90) days of the date of the Order.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondent has failed to make any payment.

Pursuant to the terms of the April 2, 2012 Order, failure to make the payment as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondent's licensee without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Heidi Schlienger's practitioner license (#44117-82) is SUSPENDED until she has complied with payment of costs and forfeitures as set forth in the April 2, 2012 Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
