

## WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES



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1. Respondent William A. Kaminski (dob 05/30/1944) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Manager, having license number 81-22920, first issued on 09/13/1978 and current through 03/31/2013. Mr. Kaminski's most recent address on

file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 1001 Fourier Drive, Madison, WI 53717.

2. Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment, having license number 80-33915, first issued on 04/10/2006, expired 04/01/2009, renewed 11/05/2010, and current through 03/31/2013. Cost Cutters (Platteville)'s most recent address on file with the Department is 1800 Progressive Parkway, Platteville, WI 53818.

3. On or about January 22, 2010, the Department received a complaint alleging unlicensed practice at Cost Cutters (Platteville) in Platteville, WI. Division of Enforcement Case Number 10 BAC 005 was subsequently opened for investigation.

4. The Department's investigation revealed the following:

- a. Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville) operated with an expired barbering and cosmetology establishment license from April 1, 2009 until the license was renewed on November 5, 2010;
- b. Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville) has operated without a manager of record since March 2010; and
- c. An unlicensed student provided barbering and cosmetology services at Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville) from December 16, 2009 until January 29, 2009.

5. Respondent Kaminski is owner of Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville). Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.06, as owner, Respondent Kaminski was at all times relevant to this matter responsible for compliance with Wis. Stat. ch. 454 and Wis. Admin. Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondents William A. Kaminski and Cost Cutters (Platteville) have violated Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 3.01(1), 3.02(1), and 2.04(1) by operating with an expired barbering and cosmetology establishment license, by failing to have a manager of record, and by allowing an unlicensed student to provide barbering and cosmetology services.

3. As a result of the above violation, Respondents William A. Kaminski and Cost Cutters (Platteville) are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i).

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
2. Respondents William A. Kaminski and Cost Cutters (Platteville) are hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent William A. Kaminski shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$1,500.00 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$373.00.
4. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent Cost Cutters (Platteville) shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$1,500.00 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$373.00.

6. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to timely submit payment of the forfeitures and costs as ordered, Respondents' licenses (nos. 81-22920 and 80-33915) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with payment of the forfeitures and costs.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
