On October 4, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's requests for reinstatement of license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 7, 2012. Based upon the information of record, which shows insufficient evidence in support of petitioner's ability to practice without supervision, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for reinstatement of the registered nurse license of Beth A. Schumacher (#149644-30) is GRANTED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for a period of at least two (2) years from the date of her nursing employment under this order, the license of Beth A. Schumacher, R.N. and her privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact, are LIMITED as follows:


- a. Petitioner shall provide her nursing employers with a copy of the Board's Orders before engaging in any nursing employment.
- b. Petitioner shall work only under direct supervision or, if in a home care setting, be employed through an agency. Petitioner shall work only in a work setting pre-approved by the Board or its designee.
- c. Petitioner shall arrange for work supervisor reports from her nursing employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance on a quarterly basis.
- d. Pursuant to Uniform Nurse Licensure Compact regulations, Petitioner's nursing practice is limited to Wisconsin during the pendency of this limitation. This requirement may be waived only upon the prior written authorization of both the Wisconsin Board of Nursing and the regulatory board in the state in which Respondent proposes to practice.
- e. Petitioner shall notify the Department Monitor of any change of nursing employment during the time in which the Order is in effect. Notification shall occur within fifteen

(15) days of a change of employment and shall include an explanation of the reasons for the change.

This order is effective on the date signed below.
