

On October 24, 2012, the Veterinary Examining Board reviewed ten (10) veterinary records submitted by Respondent pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated June 13, 2012. Following the review, the Board determined the records to be deficient in that Respondent did not indicate the proper meat and milk withholding times for all patients that received medication. Based on these deficiencies, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent shall provide the Board with veterinary records from ten (10) visits made to Client A's farm or a similar facility after October 24, 2012. Respondent shall submit the records on a date to be determined by the Department Monitor.
