ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to § 440.22, Wis. Stats., seventy-five percent of the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$19,923.47, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney James Polewski and Administrative Law Judges Amanda Tollefsen and Jennifer Nashold, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against Respondent, and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before April 10, 2013, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under § 440.22(3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
