The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Ronald G. Bovee (dob 01/07/1972) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having license number 108-34786, first issued on November 28, 2007 and current through August 31, 2012. Respondent Bovee's most recent address on file with the Department is 1515 Algoma Street, New London, WI 54961.

2. Respondent Bovee's private security person license expired on September 1, 2010. In July 2011, Respondent Bovee electronically submitted a license renewal application to the Department and answered "NO" to the following question:

HAVE YOU BEEN CONVICTED WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS OF A FELONY, A MISDEMEANOR OR A VIOLATION OF ANY STATE OR LOCAL LAW (OTHER THAN TRAFFIC) THAT IS PUNISHABLE BY A FORFEITURE, OR, ARE CHARGES PENDING? (If YES, provide information.)

3. A subsequent Department check revealed a conviction for Respondent Bovee within the two years preceding July 2011. Division of Enforcement case number 11 RSG 040 was subsequently opened for investigation.

4. Court records obtained during the course of the Department's investigation revealed that on June 13, 2011, Respondent Bovee was issued a citation for 2nd Offense Disorderly Conduct (Kewaunee County Case Number 2011FO000202). A default judgment was entered against Respondent Bovee for the offense on June 16, 2011.

5. Respondent Bovee failed to notify the Department of the conviction within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent Bovee consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Bovee engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Bovee violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(2) by failing to report a violation to the Department within 48 hours of the judgment of conviction.

4. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Bovee engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(17) by providing false information in the application for a credential.

5. As a result of the violations noted above, Respondent Bovee is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)1-4 and Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
2. Respondent Ronald G. Bovee is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent Bovee shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$411.00.
4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no. 108-34786) may, in the discretion of the Department, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
