PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. John A. Kidd, M.D., Respondent, date of birth October 9, 1965, is licensed and currently registered by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 39803-20, which was first granted on May 22, 1998.

2. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Safety and Professional Services is 72 Maryland Avenue, Saranac Lake, NY 12983.

3. Respondent's area of specialty and board-certification is anesthesiology.
4. Respondent is now practicing medicine in New York and has no intention of returning to Wisconsin to practice medicine.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).


ORDER


1. The VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT by John A. Kidd, M.D., of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and his right to renew that license because he has relocated to New York and has no intention to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin is hereby ACCEPTED.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that John A. Kidd, M.D., will not reapply for registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and that the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of the registration of John A. Kidd, M.D., from the date of this Order.
