ORDER GRANTING LIMITED LICENSE TO COMPLETE BOARD-APPROVED NURSE REFRESHER COURSE ORDER OTO 1998

The applicant, JANICE K. BOICE, applied for a nursing license by endorsement and has not been employed in a position that requires a nursing license within 5 years of her application and is therefore required to complete a nurse refresher course pursuant to sec. 441.06(1), Stats. and N3.04(1m), Wis. Admin. Code. The applicant knowingly and voluntarily agrees to the issuance of a LIMITED license for the sole purpose of taking a nurse refresher course..

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a LIMITED license shall be GRANTED to the applicant for the sole purpose of allowing her to complete the board approved nurse refresher course. The limited license does not authorize the applicant to engage in any other nursing employment in the state of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the limited license shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance and shall not be renewed except by petition to the board with good cause shown for lack of timely completion of the refresher course. Upon successful completion of the nursing refresher course the applicant may petition the board for a full license.
