The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Mick W. Rotta (dob 04/09/1985) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having license number 108-36686, first issued on August 28, 2008 and current through August 31, 2012. Respondent Rotta's most recent address on file with the Department is W278 N2855 Lincoln Ave., Pewaukee, WI 53072.

2. On or about February 7, 2012, Respondent Rotta self-reported to the Department that he was convicted of a disorderly conduct on January 19, 2012. Division of Enforcement case number 12 RSG 007 was subsequently opened for investigation.

3. Court records obtained during the course of the Department's investigation revealed that on May 22, 2010, Respondent Rotta was issued a citation for Obstructing an Officer (Lake Country Municipal Court Citation Number 11853123). On January 19, 2012, Respondent Rotta was convicted of an amended charge of Disorderly Conduct.

4. Respondent Rotta failed to notify the Department of the conviction within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent Rotta consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Rotta engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Rotta violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(2) by failing to report a conviction to the Department within 48 hours of the judgment of conviction.

4. As a result of the violations noted above, Respondent Rotta is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 440.26(6)(a)1, 2 and 4 and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
2. Respondent Mick W. Rotta is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent Rotta shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$355.00.
4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no. 108-36686) may, in the discretion of the Department, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
