PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This matter comes before the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board (Board) as citations that Respondent Nadir Mustafa has failed to pay. Based on the record in this case, the Board adopts as its Final Decision in this matter the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Nadir Mustafa (dob 5/3/1972) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a barbering or cosmetology manager, having license number 81-29905. This license was first granted to Respondent on 4/16/2004 and is current through 3/31/2013.
- 2. The most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) for Respondent is 5041 N 46th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53218. In July 2012, the United States Post Office indicated that Mr. Mustafa is no longer at that address and that his current address is 3855 N 84th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53222.

- 3. Following inspections performed on February 25, 2011 and January 26, 2012, Respondent was issued two \$1000 citations. Both citations were personally served on Respondent on January 26, 2012. One citation was for allowing Alonzo Winters to practice barbering or cosmetology without a license on February 25, 2011. The other citation was issued because Respondent was providing services in an unlicensed establishment. True and correct copies of these citations are attached as Exhibit A and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. More than 20 days have passed since Respondent was served with the citations on January 26, 2012.
- 5. Respondent has not paid the citations that were issued to Respondent on January 26, 2012.
- 6. Respondent has not submitted a written plea contesting the cited violations and has not submitted a written request for a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15.
- 2. Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(1) by assisting in the unlicensed practice of barbering and cosmetology.
- 3. Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.045(1) by providing services outside of a licensed establishment.
- 4. As a result, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i).
- 5. Respondent is in default pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § BC 10.07(1) for failing to make a deposit.
- 6. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § BC 10.07(1), the Board has the authority to issue an order of default against Respondent for the amounts identified in the citation without further proceedings.

ORDER

- 1. Respondent Nadir Mustafa is in DEFAULT and shall pay to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services a total forfeiture in the amount of \$2000 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
- 2. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to:

- 3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a refusal to renew credentialing or additional disciplinary action.
