#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On May 2, 2012, the Division of Enforcement filed a formal complaint against Respondent Antwan T. Langford in this matter. Respondent failed to answer the complaint and failed to appear at a June 7, 2012 telephone prehearing conference. On June 15, 2012, the Division of Enforcement filed a Motion for Default Judgment. On August 22, 2012, prior to issuance of a decision on the Motion for Default Judgment, Respondent contacted the Division of Hearings and Appeals regarding this case. On August 28, 2012, the administrative law judge held a status conference during which Respondent indicated his willingness to resolve this matter by stipulation.

Prior to a hearing or issuance of a final judgment in this case, the parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Antwan T. Langford (dob October 5, 1978) is licensed as a Private Security Person in the state of Wisconsin, having license number 108-1123, first issued on July 1, 1997 and current through August 31, 2012. Mr. Langford's address is 10262 West Fountain Avenue, Apt. 1402, Milwaukee, WI 53224.
- 2. On December 8, 2009, Mr. Langford was convicted of one count of misdemeanor Carrying a Concealed Weapon in Milwaukee County, Wisconsin Circuit Court.
- 3. Mr. Langford has carried a firearm following his misdemeanor conviction on December 8, 2009.
- 4. In resolution of this matter, Antwan T. Langford consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a) and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Antwan T. Langford violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 34.01(1)(e) by carrying a firearm after he was convicted of misdemeanor carrying a concealed weapon.
- 3. By carrying a concealed weapon in violation of a criminal law, Antwan T. Langford engaged in conduct reflecting adversely on professional qualification pursuant to:
  - a. Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person; and
  - b. Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(8) by violating state or federal law rules or regulations related to the care, handling or use of firearms.
- 4. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent Antwan T. Langford is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01.

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Respondent Antwan T. Langford is REPRIMANDED.

3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
