On September 27, 2012, the Department of Safety and Professional Services filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the board ordered full costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent pursuant to s. 440.22, Wis. Stats. Pursuant to sec. SPS 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about September 25, 2012, the Department of Safety and Professional Services received the Affidavit of Costs in the amount of \$892.50 filed by Attorney Sarah Norberg. On or about October 1, 2012, the Department of Safety and Professional Services received the Affidavit of Costs from the Division of Hearings and Appeals in the amount of \$298.90, filed by Administrative Law Judge Jennifer E. Nashold. The Department of Safety and Professional Services considered the Affidavits of Costs on October 24, 2012, and orders as follows:

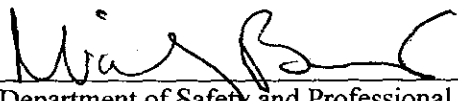
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the full costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,191.40 set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Sarah Norberg and Administrative Law Judge Jennifer Nashold, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of respondent to make payment on or before August 14, 2013 shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the board grants a different deadline.** Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.
