On October 25, 2012, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Department ordered that pursuant to §440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against the Respondent. The Department received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Enforcement and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Department considered the Affidavits of Costs on November 16, 2012 and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to § 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,584.42 set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Sarah Norberg and Administrative Law Judge Jennifer Nashold, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against Respondent, and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before May 15, 2013 shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for and the Department grants a different deadline.** Under § 440.22(3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
