FINDINGS OF FACT

1. BENJAMIN RASZEJA has filed an application for a credential to practice as a private security person in Wisconsin.
2. Information received in the application process reflects that on or about the dates of 12/1/99, 2/13/01 and 12/17/07. Applicant was convicted of violation of:

Wis. Stat. § 943.01(1) CRIMINAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY (939.05 PARTY TO A CRIME) – MISDEMEANOR A

Wis. Statute § 943.20(1)(a) THEFT-MOVABLE PROPERTY <= \$1000 (939.05 PARTY TO A CRIME) – MISDEMEANOR A

Wis. Stat. § 63.01 DISORDERLY CONDUCT – FORFEITURE U

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.

2. The facts and circumstances of the arrest referenced above substantially relate to the practice of a private security person. Applicant by his conduct is subject to action against his license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that BENJAMIN RASZEJA is GRANTED a PRIVATE SECURITY PERMIT subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Practice Limitations

1. Applicant may not carry a weapon in conjunction with employment for a term of two years. Additionally, applicant must inform employer of the Department's order of restrictions. Applicant must not commit any new crimes.

Petitions for Modification

2. Applicant may petition the Department for modification of the terms of this Order after completion of one year of practice in compliance with all terms and conditions of this Order. Applicant's petition must include his history of employment from the effective date of this Order that states the dates and names of any employer, such employment in total equaling one year of practice. Any such petition shall be accompanied by a written recommendation from Applicant's current employer that includes, among other things, the dates of employment and scope of responsibility during such employment, and (if applicable) his treatment provider expressly supporting the specific modifications sought. A denial of such a petition for modification shall not be deemed a denial of license under Wis. Stats. §§ 227.01(3), or 227.42, or Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 1, and shall not be subject to any right to further hearing or appeal.

Summary Suspension/Additional Discipline

3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event that the Respondent fails to submit quarterly reports as ordered, Respondent's license may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this order.
