The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Dentistry Examining (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent David P. Stangl, D.D.S., (dob: January 21, 1940) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a dentist, having license number 15-500224, first issued on June 18, 1965, and current through September 30, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is W68 N930 Washington Avenue, Cedarburg, WI 53012.

2. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance has received a referral regarding Respondent's practice of dentistry, specifically noting a settlement of a claim that Respondent improperly used orthodontic rubber bands on a patient, causing minor permanent injury. Respondent does not agree that his conduct in that incident was below the acceptable standards of dentistry, but recognizes that there is evidence on which the Board could conclude that he failed to meet acceptable standards in that incident.

3. Respondent is recovering from serious health concerns, has decided to retire from the practice of dentistry, and has tendered the surrender of his license to practice dentistry.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. The SURRENDER of Respondent David P. Stangl's license to practice dentistry in Wisconsin is accepted.
3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
