The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a private detective agency, having license number 62-15583, first issued on 6/16/1995 and current through 8/31/2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 7635 W. Oklahoma Avenue, Suite 104, Milwaukee, WI 53219-4852.

2. Between 2002 and July 2012, Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. failed to timely notify the Department when licensed security guards left Respondent's employment.

3. Starting in July 2012, Respondent modified its internal procedures to ensure compliance with the requirement that it notify the Department when licensed security guards terminate their employment with Respondent.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in paragraph 2 of the Findings of Fact, Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 32.06(2) by failing to notify the Department in writing within 5 days after the termination of employment of a private security person.

3. Therefore, Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)(4).

### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. (license number 62-15583) is **REPRIMANDED**.

3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent U.S. Security Associates Inc. shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$550.

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no. 62-15583) may, in the discretion of the Department, be **SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
