The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Robin R. Easter (dob 10/09/1963) was licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner, having license number 82-89650, first issued on March 16, 2009, and expired on April 1, 2011. Respondent Easter's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 2941A N. 56th St., Milwaukee, WI 53210.

2. On June 1, 2012, a Department investigator performed an unannounced inspection of Changing Faces Beauty Salon. The inspection and follow-up investigation revealed that Respondent Easter was providing barbering and cosmetology services with an expired license.

3. In resolution of this matter, Respondent Easter consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Easter violated Wis. Stat. § 454.04(1)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § 2.04(1) by practicing barbering and cosmetology with an expired license.

3. As a result of the above violations, Respondent Easter is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 454.15(2)(i) and 454.15(3).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

2. Respondent Robin R. Easter is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent Easter shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$1,000.00 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$115.00.

4. Payment of forfeiture and costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as ordered, Respondent's license (no. 82-89650) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the forfeiture and costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
