The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Physical Therapy Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent David L. Zwieg, P.T., (dob May 13, 1957) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin to practice physical therapy, having license number 24-2325, first issued on November 10, 1980 and current through February 28, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is W10177 Hickory Bay Road, Fox Lake, Wisconsin 53933.

2. On June 19, 2012, the North Carolina Board of Physical Therapy Examiners issued a disciplinary Warning to Respondent based on inaccurate record keeping.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Physical Therapy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.57, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent David L. Zwieg, P.T., engaged in unprofessional conduct pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § PHT 7.02(17) by having disciplinary action taken against his license in another state.

3. As a result of the above violations, David L. Zwieg, P.T., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.57(2).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent David L. Zwieg, P.T., is REPRIMANDED.

3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent David L. Zwieg, P.T., shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$100.00.

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of costs as ordered, Respondent's license (no. 24-2325) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
