The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Jed L. Brundidge (dob March 18, 1986) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having license number 108-33151, first issued on April 12, 2007, and current through August 31, 2014. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 725 Waterworks Rd., Nekoosa, WI 54457.

2. In August 2012, Respondent submitted a Report of Conviction form to the Department indicating an Operating While Intoxicated 2nd Offense conviction. On August 27,

2012, the matter was referred to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and Case Number 12 RSG 027 was subsequently opened for investigation.

3. Court records obtained from Respondent revealed that on December 21, 2011, Respondent was charged with misdemeanor Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense and misdemeanor Operating with Prohibited Alcohol Concentration – 2nd Offense (Wood County Case Number 2011CT000530).

4. On March 2, 2012, the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense charge was dismissed and Respondent was convicted of Operating w/ PAC (2nd).

5. Respondent failed to notify the Department in writing within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Jed L. Brundidge engaged in conduct reflecting adversely on his professional qualification pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(2) by failing to report his conviction to the Department within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction.

4. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)1, 2 and 4 and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01.

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent Jed L. Brundidge is REPRIMANDED.

3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$211.00.

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no.108-33151) may, in the discretion of the Department, be **SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
