The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Erik L. Vo (dob July 4, 1987) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Boxing Contestant, having license number 263-440, first issued on September 14, 2012, and current through September 14, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 705 Rhomberg, Dubuque, IA 52001.

2. On August 31, 2012, Respondent entered into a contract to participate in a professional boxing match of four bouts on September 15, 2012, at the maximum weight of 129 pounds.

3. On September 14, 2012, Respondent weighed-in at 139.6 pounds.
4. Due to Respondent's weight exceeding the weight specified in the contract, the boxing match was cancelled.
5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 444.11, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Erik L. Vo violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 113.04(2) by exceeding the weight specified in the contract between himself and a promoter or club.
3. As a result of the violation noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 444.11 and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 116.01(3)(a) and (L).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Erik L. Vo's boxing contestant license (number 263-440) is SUSPENDED for a period of 30 days beginning January 14, 2013.
3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$218.00.
4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

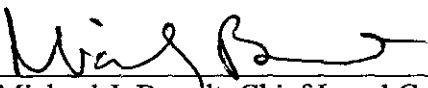

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no. 263-440) may, in the discretion of the Department, be

SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
