On September 14, 2010, the Board of Nursing issued an Order Imposing Current Standard Impairment Requirements and Granting Stay of Suspension ("Order") which suspended Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#106610-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent was granted an immediate stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

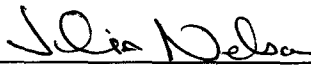
On April 11, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request for access to controlled substances and the ability to work in an agency setting, currently prohibited pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which includes evidence of insufficient time under the terms of the Order and information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for modification of the terms, specifically access to controlled substances and ability to work in an agency setting, is hereby DENIED.
