On December 13, 2007, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#137557-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 11, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the annual frequency of drug and alcohol screens, required pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a modification to the frequency of drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Respondent shall now undergo drug and alcohol screens at a frequency of not less than 14 times per year, with one annual hair test.

All other terms and conditions of the December 13, 2007 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
