On April 9, 2008, the Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin (#12259-40) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 15, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, including evidence that Respondent has demonstrated continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order and qualifies for full licensure, the Board finds and makes the following:



ORDER
