ORDER

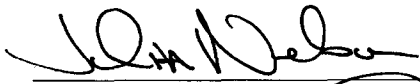
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for return to full licensure status of the registered nurse license of Larisa Klein (#126165-30) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modifications of drug screens under the limitations on the registered nurse license of Larisa Klein (#126165-30) is GRANTED and the limitation is modified to fourteen (14) urine screens and one (1) hair screen..

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that Ms. Klein not petition the board for modifications earlier than December 6, 2013.
