ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Paula Salkin (#84037-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until such time as Respondent obtains nursing employment. At such time the drug screen frequency shall increase to at least fifty five (55) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.

All other terms and conditions of the September 4, 2008 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
