On April 22, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing granted Respondent an initial stay of the suspension of Respondent's nursing license, pursuant to the Board Order dated April 2, 2009 ("Order"). ORDER

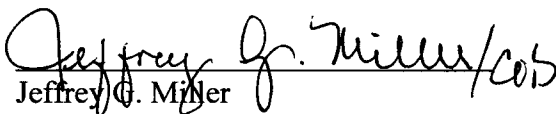

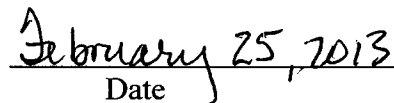
