On November 6, 2008, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license in the state of Wisconsin for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 12, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request to suspend, or reduce, the requirement for drug and alcohol screens until she returns to the practice of nursing. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

#### **ORDER**

- 1. Respondent's request for a modification to the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test until she obtains employment as a nurse, at which time the frequency may be increased to a minimum of 28 urine screens per year plus one annual hair test.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
