On April 2, 2009, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#98101-30). The Board has granted a stay of suspension, permitting Respondent to practice under a limited license with certain terms and conditions.

On May 9, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request to modify the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and remove the limitation from her license, or reinstate the license, or to terminate work site limitations pursuant to the above Order. Based upon the information of record, which shows Respondent has not demonstrated sufficient time under the Order and based on the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a modification to the frequency of drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request to remove the limitations from her license be, and hereby is, DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request for termination of work site limitations be, and hereby is, GRANTED.

All other terms and conditions of the April 2, 2009 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
