On May 7, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension, which is contingent upon her compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.

Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent has violated the terms and conditions of the Order, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The stay of suspension is REMOVED and Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse (#149909-30) is SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. Respondent may petition for reinstatement of the stay after demonstrating, to the satisfaction of the Board or its designee, continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order for at least the most recent three (3) months.
3. This Order is effective immediately.
