On May 7, 2009, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#154951-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 9, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the annual frequency of drug and alcohol screens and a request for access to controlled substances, pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which includes evidence of failure to comply with the Board's Order regarding screening, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

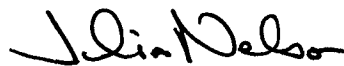
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for modification of the terms, specifically a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens, is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED.
