On July 23, 2009, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#112040-30). The Board has granted a stay of suspension, permitting Respondent to practice under a limited license with certain terms and conditions.

On May 9, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request to modify the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and terminate the therapy requirement from her license, pursuant to the above Order. Based upon the information of record, which shows Respondent has been compliant with the terms and conditions thus far but does not have her therapist's recommendation to terminate drug and alcohol screens, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

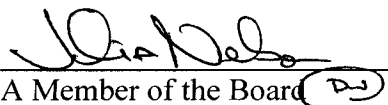
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a modification to terminate the therapy requirement be, and hereby is, GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request to terminate the requirement for drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, DENIED.

All other terms and conditions of the July 23, 2009 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
