ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Luann Kay (Rusch) Taylor (#81404-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until such time as Luann Kay (Rusch) Taylor obtains nursing employment. At such time the drug screen frequency shall increase to at least forty-eight (48) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
