On March 25, 2010, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license practical nursing license in the state of Wisconsin (#30413-31) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 11, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request for termination of therapy and a reduction in the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the lack of time under the Board Order and information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

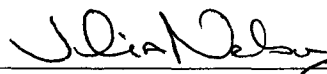
ORDER
