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On March 14, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered the respondent's request for a modification to decrease the frequency of drug screens from 47 drug screens to 14 drug screens and 1 hair test pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated May 6, 2010. Based upon the information of record, which shows Respondent has insufficient time under the order to be granted that large a reduction in drug screens, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED the request for modification of the limitation on the registered nurse license of Jill Gustafson (#202186-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens to 14 drug screens and 1 annual hair test is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a reduction in the frequency of Ms. Gustafson's drug screens to 28 per year and one annual hair test is hereby GRANTED.
