On June 2, 2011, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for a minimum of two (2) years, effective retroactively on December 4, 2009. Respondent was ordered to complete certain conditions prior to petitioning for termination of the suspension. Upon termination of the suspension, Respondent's license shall be limited pursuant to the terms specified in the Order.

On August 8, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the suspension on her professional nursing license. In support of her request, Respondent submitted evidence of completion for the required conditions. Based on the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's request to terminate the suspension of her professional nursing license in the state of Wisconsin (#156706-30) is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's professional nursing license, and her privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact, is LIMITED with the terms and conditions specified in the June 2, 2011 Final Decision and Order.
3. All terms and conditions of the June 2, 2011 Final Decision and Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
